






The Foundry BC Platform

Health care providers interact with the platform via a clinician/staff portal.

• Young people and families/caregivers involved come from all over BC, with a focus on young people from rural and remote communities.

• They co-designed every piece of the app and continue to co-design ongoing development and the Foundry Virtual Program, including:

- Reminder system
- Modalities offered for virtual appointments






Foundry BC Platform - History and Timeline

Foundry BC Platform – Current Features


- Allows young people and families/caregivers to schedule virtual and in-person appointments
- Inbox: a secure way to message clients in between appointments when needed
- Ability to configure role and appointment types to match Foundry centres' needs
- Online walk-in queue with manual triaging
- My Story: Allows young people and families/caregivers to only tell their story once, in their own words
- Ability to choose between a local Foundry centre and Foundry Virtual
- Toolbox integration: Automatically registers young people and families/caregivers in our data collection platform when they sign up for an account and sends them the needed surveys automatically





Foundry BC Platform – Future Features

- More fulsome Toolbox integration
- Action Plan: Track goals and progress collaboratively with service provider
- Medication History Log: Track current and past prescribed medication
- Features to increase adoption and ease of implementation at Foundry centres
- Gamification







Who is accessing the Foundry BC Platform?






Question for Youth:
