

## Steps to Save Login Credentials

By following these steps, you can securely save your login credentials for the Foundry website in both your browser and app:

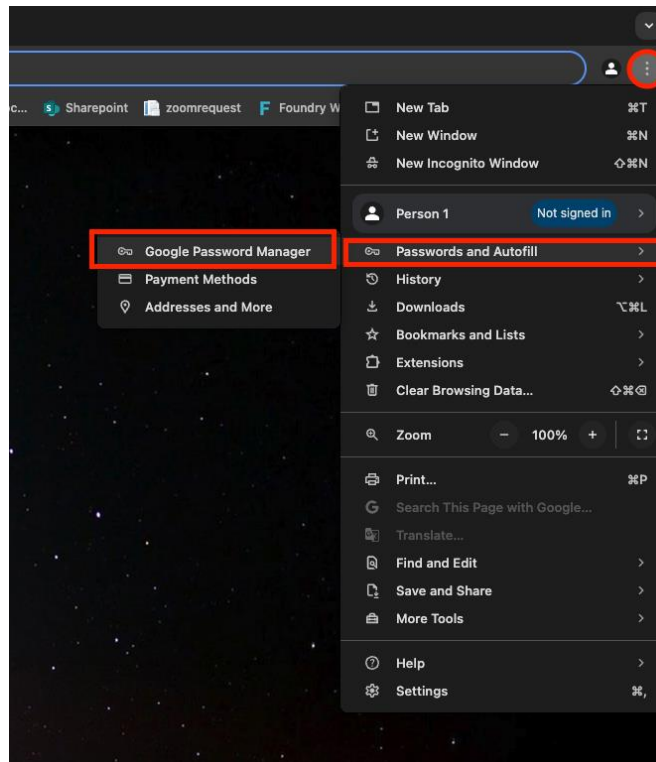
1. **Navigate to the Login Page:** Visit the Foundry app/website and enter your email and password.
2. **Save Password Prompt:** After clicking "Sign In" if prompted, click "Save password" to save your login information.

### Manually Saving Credentials:

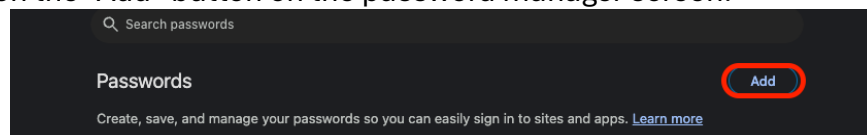
If you are unable to see the save password prompt, please follow the steps outlined below:

#### Browser (Chrome):

- Go to Menu -> Passwords and Autofill -> Google Password Manager -> Add.



- Click on the "Add" button on the password manager screen.



- Enter the site as "foundrybc.ca" along with your email address and password, then click "Save."

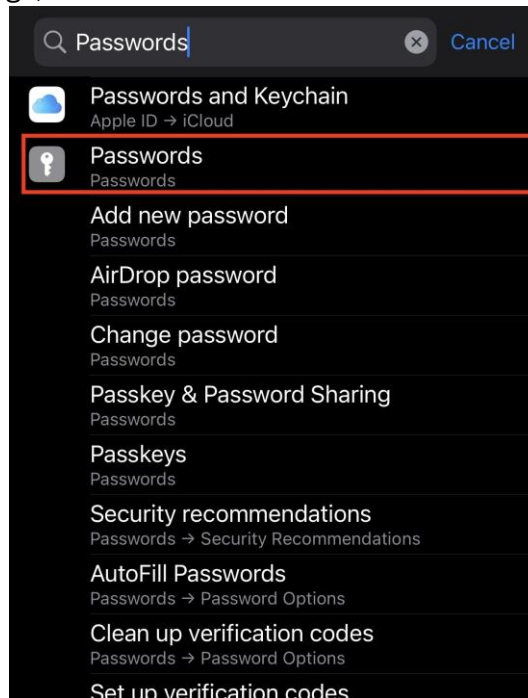

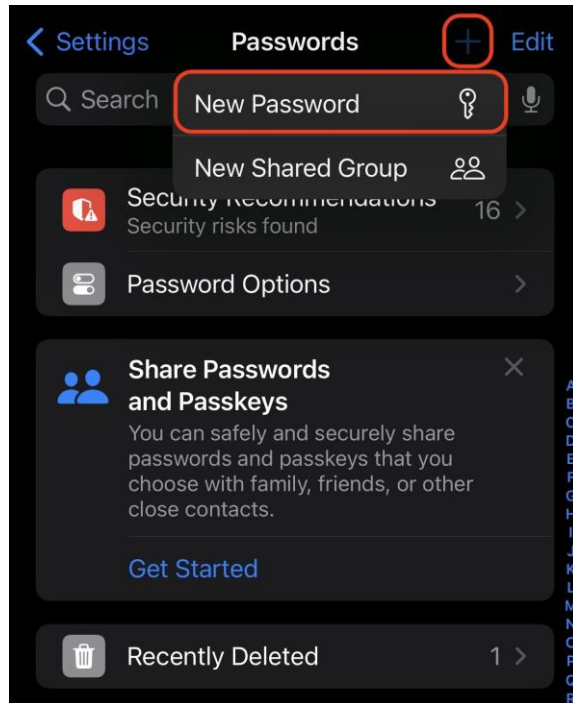
- You can also view and edit your saved passwords in Google Password Manager.

## IOS:

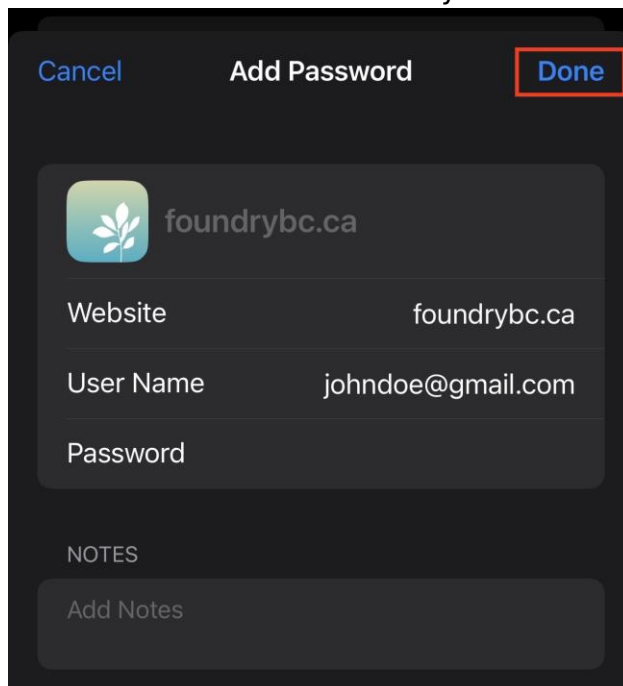
- In the device settings, search and select the "Passwords" button.



- Click on the “+” icon -> “new password” to add new credentials



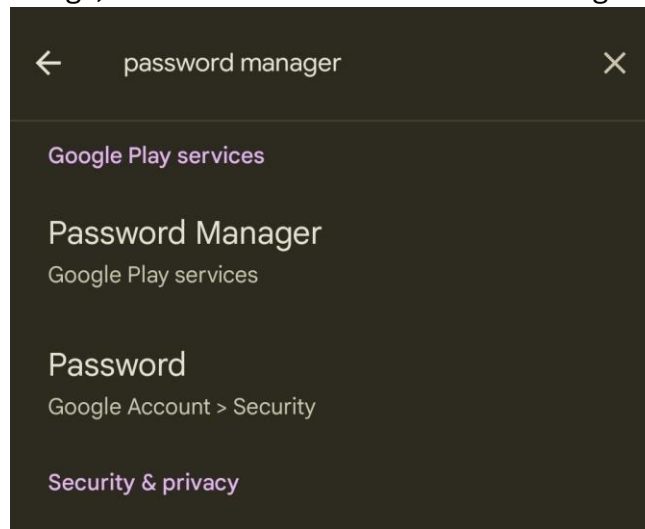
- Add your credentials and set the site as “foundrybc.ca” and click on “done” to save



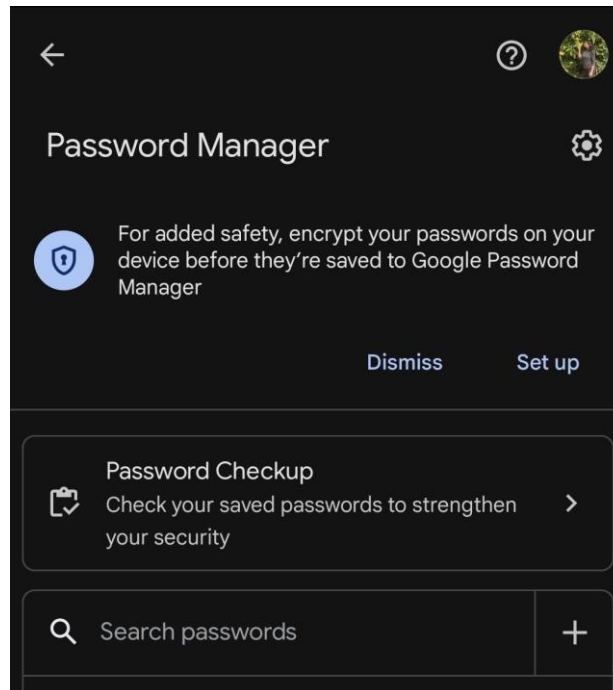
- You can also edit or remove saved passwords from the same settings window.

## Android:


- In the device settings, search and select "Password manager" option.
