QUALIFICATIONS

Education and Experience:

- Master's Degree in an applicable social or health sciences program such as Counselling Psychology.
- Three to five (3-5) years recent, related experience with youth in a mental health/substance use setting, or an equivalent combination of education, training and experience.
- The preferred candidate will also have experience with substance use challenges and supervision experience. Registered with relevant/applicable professional association.

 population.
