JOB SUMMARY:

Provides counselling and assessments to individuals and families, who are clients of Foundry Abbotsford. Foundry is a new provincial initiative that integrates services for youth 12-24 years old in primary care, social services, mental health, substance use and peer support. The clinician will utilize the Brief Solution Focused Therapy model to provide walk-in counselling to youth at Foundry Abbotsford. The clinician will assist with mental health assessments and provision of one-on-one support to Foundry clients that do not fit the requirements of specific Foundry Abbotsford mental health pathways. The clinician will facilitate groups as needed. In addition one of the counsellors will provide in office and outreach counselling, including in schools, to youth and families.

QUALIFICATION AND EXPERIENCE:

A Master Level degree in Counselling, Social Work, Psychology or in a related field. Demonstrated skills and experience with youth and/or families. Proven ability to work effectively during crisis. Excellent organization, time and general management skills. Excellent networking skills. Proven knowledge of variety of counselling techniques. Experience in trauma work, DBT, EFFT and Brief Solution Focused Therapy an asset. Experience working with substance use and concurrent disorders.
