

JOB SUMMARY

This position provides short-term counselling to youth, parents and families at the Youth Resource Centre, at schools and occasionally at people's homes. Higher acuity needs are addressed with the goal to shorten the period that youth/families require overall service. The person will also provide counselling and therapeutic interventions one-on-one or in groups to students in alternate classrooms at local high schools.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Facilitate short-term counselling for youth using a Solution Focused Brief Therapy model and a trauma informed lens. This includes working with youth in crisis.
- Establish supportive and trusting relationships that reduce risk and promote positive choices.
- Works with parents and caregivers to address historic issues that interfere with parenting and current functioning.
- Coordinates with other community partners including specialized services if necessary.
- Might facilitate groups for youth and/or parents on a variety of mental health related topics.
- Is able to use a variety of counselling modalities to meet client's needs including but not limited to CBT, DBT, MI, SFBT, EFFT and trauma informed approaches.
- Flexible workhours including into the evening are required.

A Master Level degree in Counselling, Social Work, Psychology or in a related field. Direct program delivery experience in the community social services sector with a demonstrated working knowledge of government and community based programs and related provincial and community support systems. Demonstrated skills and experience with youth. Proven ability to work effectively during crisis. Excellent organization, time and general management skills. Excellent networking skills.
