What can the program help me with?

- One-on-one employment counselling to explore interests and existing challenges.
- Direct support with resumes, cover letters and application processes.
- Financial resources and/or support.
- Navigating possible pathways for post-secondary education, group workshops or certification programs if you are interested in learning new skills.
- Assistance connecting with other employers and Foundry staff/supports.

How is it different from other work & education programs?

- In addition to help with employment and education, you will be able to connect to other Foundry services (peer support, counselling, etc.) to ensure you feel supported in all areas of your life.
- The program is absolutely FREE. You may also be able to access money to help cover some of the costs related to your goals.
- In terms of time commitment, you can continue the program for as long or as little as you like, based on your unique needs.

Who can join the program?

BC youth between 15-24 experiencing barriers to finding school, work or training who are:

- Interested in working, going to school, or starting a training program.
- Legally entitled to work in BC.
- Not already working, in a school/training program; or in less than 15hrs of these.
