How is it different from other work & education programs?

• In addition to help with education & employment, we provide connections to other Foundry services (peer support, counselling, etc.) to ensure youth feel supported in all areas of life.

How might your educational institute benefit from this partnership?

- 1:1 educational counselling to help students explore interests and find programs/courses that are in alignment with their goals and curricula.
- The program is absolutely FREE. Youth may also be able to access money to help cover some of the costs related to their goals.
- Support is individualized and flexible; the program can be continued for longer or shorter based on young people's unique needs.
- Additional support with navigating pathways and application processes for post-secondary education or certification programs.
- Increased access to financial information and aid.
- Assistance connecting with program administrators, facilitators and Foundry staff/supports to build relationships necessary for young people to be successful in their educational goals.

Who can join the program?

BC youth between 15-24 experiencing barriers to finding school, work or training who are:

- Interested in working, going to school, or starting a training program.
- Not already working, in a school/training program; or in less than 15hrs of these.
- Legally entitled to work in BC.

Everyone benefits when schools and communities work together to support student outcomes.
