Thank you for your interest in Foundry's Youth and Family Ambassador Program (YFAP), an exciting community-based, nation-wide initiative designed to provide a space for youth and families interested in, and working toward, the development of Integrated Youth Services (IYS) in their communities. The term "Integrated Youth Services" refers to a wide a variety of health and social services that work together through meaningful community partnerships to treat a young person holistically, whatever their needs may be. Through this program you will have a unique opportunity to contribute to the transformation of these services in your community, whether that means building a wellness centre or starting a community dialogue. You will participate in a network for IYS advocacy, sharing your experiences with other ambassadors across the country.

### As an ambassador, you will have opportunities to:

- Work virtually with a small cohort of ambassadors to develop an IYS project (which could be the co-creation of resources/tools, research, or an activity);
- Participate in ongoing virtual training (i.e., facilitation skills, project management, community development) to support you as you develop your project;
- Share your experiences, learnings, questions, and ideas with other ambassadors in your cohort through regular virtual meetings (every second month, all cohorts will meet together); and,
- Participate in a virtual National IYS Conference in the spring of 2024 bringing together youth and families to share experiences and champion IYS.

You will have access to ongoing support from a team at Foundry's central office. Honoraria will be provided.

#### Your time commitment will be:

May 2023 to March 2024 3 to 4 Hours per month

We aim to recruit as diverse a group as possible. Participants will ideally have lived/living experience with, or have cared for a young person with, mental health and/or substance use challenges. The ability to work remotely is required.
